In 2021, their son, Zane Moscow, was born at 30 weeks. Zane spent 10 weeks in the Northside Hospital NICU (Neonatal Intensive Care Unit). Without researched and medical breakthroughs funded by organizations like the March of Dimes, Zane would not be alive and thriving today. Since 2023, the Moscow Family has worked to raise money and awareness for the March of Dimes. The March of Dimes mission is to lead the fight for the health of all moms and babies, end the preventable maternal health risks and deaths, end preventable preterm birth and infant death and close the health equity gap.
